



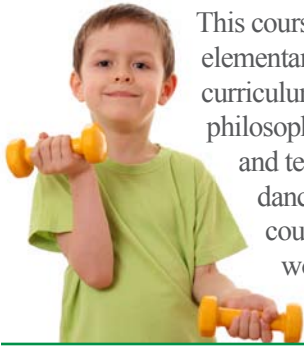
Physical Education Summer Institute – 2010
